Werner Electric Supply: Dodd-Frank Act Conflict Materials Compliance

To whom it may concern:

On July 21, 2010, Congress passed the Dodd-Frank Act (the "Act"). The Act directs the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (the "SEC") to adopt rules requiring certain companies to provide disclosures regarding the use of specified "conflict materials" emanating from the Democratic Republic of Congo and nine (9) adjoining countries. On August 22, 2012, the SEC adopted rules regarding conflict materials disclosure. The rules *only* apply to companies that file reports with the SEC pursuant to Sections 13(a) or 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

Werner Electric Supply, as a privately held company, does not file, and is not required to file with the SEC. However, we fully support the ethical goals of the Conflict Minerals legislation. We will also support our customers, as needed, in their efforts to become compliant.
