



30% Tax Credits Are Extended For Electric Vehicle Charging Stations

Take advantage of the **Federal 30% Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (EVSE) Tax Credit** which has been reinstated and extended through 2021. EVSE Tax Credits which previously expired in 2017 are now retroactive back to January 2018 and extend through December 31, 2021.



When does the Tax Credit apply?

- On purchases of public or private charging stations
- On either Level-2 or DC Fast Charging stations
- End-user must own and have paid for the station and/or installation costs
 - For CPaaS (ChargePoint as a Service) customers, the tax credit only applies to make ready costs

What is the credit amount?

30% off total installed costs!

- Maximum \$30,000 per address for commercial taxpayers
- Maximum \$1,000 per address for individual taxpayers

How is the tax credit collected?

- Fill out IRS Form 8911 - Alternative Fuel Vehicle Refueling Property Credit, as part of your annual tax filing. There's no need to complete or submit additional forms prior to your annual filing.
